OMA has established an archive collection at the Brethren Historical Library and Archives in Elgin, IL. The purpose of this collection is to keep historical documents together, in a safe environment, and accessible for denominational use and research. Some of the items of interest for this growing collection include:

- Flyers, programs, minutes, and photos of National Conferences and Annual Retreats (formally Director/Manager Retreats)
- Environmental Grant project write-ups and photos
- Annual Conference insight sessions descriptions and program outlines
- Photos and citations of Staff and Volunteer Award recipients
- Steering Committee minutes

Items should be sent to the current OMA Steering Committee vice-chairperson who will serve as the archivist during their term. At the end of their term (approximately every three years), the collected materials will be forwarded on to Elgin
